

COMPETITION RULES

Design and Build an all-weather cardboard shelter

Rules:

- ◆ The Competition will take place on the Cathedral Green on West Street in Chichester on Saturday 30 October 2010.
- ◆ Shelters can be built between 2.00pm and 3.30 pm, it is best to register in advance via our website by Friday 15 October, however registrations received up to and on the day will be accepted.
- ◆ Judging will take place at 3.30 pm.
- ◆ Entries will be judged in three categories of schools, churches, businesses and general public.
- ◆ Shelters must be built from cardboard boxes which we will provide and re-cycled materials which you might find in a skip.
- ◆ The Shelter should be big enough to sleep in — it is hoped that competitors will sleep in their shelters during the Sleep Out, maximum size is approximately the size of an average doorway per person (1.5 sqm) for space to build and sleep. Teams are welcome to join their shelters to create more room. Some shelters may need to be moved to a designated sleeping area after judging.
- ◆ Competitors can build their shelters in groups of between 2 – 6 people, each team that wish to sleep out has a sponsorship target of £400 to aim for. Money can be raised by yourself, as a team, or raise half and organise for your company/school/church to match this.
- ◆ Ground sheets may be used and it is advisable to bring along some waterproof material like plastic sheeting to cover the shelter in case of rain.
- ◆ The competition entries will be featured on the Stonepillow website and in our newsletter
- ◆ If using cardboard boxes, please ensure that you remove them in the morning along with any other waste material and take it to the rubbish collection point at the top of the steps on West Street for collection at 8am.

PRIZES

Engraved trophies will be given for 1st & 2nd place, 3rd place will be in the form of a certificate.
